I. KEY RESULTS OF ACTIVITIES OF THE EURASIAN PEOPLES' ASSEMBLY

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly is an International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations and citizens with an active life position, sharing and promoting the ideas and values of Eurasian integration, the protection of peace, the strengthening of friendship, harmony, partnership and good-neighbourliness among peoples. It is these ideas and values that are the top-priority issues on the international agenda for the salvation of the common future of humanity.

The major activity of the Assembly is the implementation of various projects and activities aimed at strengthening the integration processes. The Assembly focuses on economic issues, priorities in culture, sports, education, and youth policy.

In modern conditions, public diplomacy plays a key role in ensuring trust and mutual understanding between States and peoples in the search for ways to jointly overcome the current global crisis and effectively confront new threats.

The unity realized by the peoples will make it possible to realize the importance of joint construction of a large Eurasian partnership.

Today, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly members are representatives of more than 40 countries: Austria, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Vietnam, Germany, Greece, Georgia, Denmark, Israel, India, Iraq, Italy, Kazakhstan, Cameroon, China, Korea, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Lithuania, Macedonia, Moldova, Mongolia, Palestine, Russia, Serbia, Slovenia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Uzbekistan, Ukraine, Finland, France, Montenegro, Czech Republic, Switzerland, Estonia, USA.

Members of the Assembly are united by:

- common goals and aspirations to make the world stable, free from wars, violence and suffering;
 - common responsibility to history for the preservation of the predecessors' achievements;
- responsibility to the future for the preservation of the ethno-cultural identity of all peoples, spiritual and moral ideals and the transfer of social experience to subsequent generations.

Despite the difficult modern conditions, the acute situation with the coronavirus pandemic, the Assembly continues to expand interaction with partners from different countries, implementing projects and activities aimed at strengthening integration processes and peacemaking through diversified cultural, humanitarian and economic cooperation, both in offline and online modes, since the emerging global problems can only be solved together, by the whole world.

In the Year of Memory and Glory, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, supported by partners from different countries, implemented the International Megaproject «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER - in the name of Peace and Creation». The Project included public initiatives aimed at preserving the memory of the Great Patriotic War and the Second World War. The International Public Forum «Preserving the Memory of the Second World and the Great Patriotic Wars» became the binding basis of the project. Its sessions were held in the famous Livadia and Vorontsov Palaces in Crimea, as well as in the «House of Friendship of the Leningrad Region» in St. Petersburg and the Museum «Road of Life» in the Leningrad region.

The formation of the Representative Offices of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly has proven itself positively. The established Representative Offices are actively involved in the development and implementation of interesting programs, unique projects and diverse events related to the statutory activities of the Assembly. II. GENERAL COUNCIL MEETINGS AND MEETINGS OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL PRESIDIUM

January 31, Russia, Moscow

An Expanded meeting of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly was held in the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation. The meeting, chaired by the Secretary General of the Assembly, Andrei Belyaninov, was attended by members of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, representatives of international interstate and non-governmental organizations, representatives of federal and regional authorities of the Russian Federation, experts and journalists. The General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly gathered citizens of more than 20 countries of Eurasia.



Svetlana Smirnova, First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, announced the outcome of the Assembly's activities in 2019 and the Work Plan of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly for 2020. Welcoming words to the participants were addressed by: Iosif Diskin, Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Chairman of the Commission of the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation on the harmonization of interethnic and interreligious relations; Mr Datla Bala Venkatesh Varma, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of India to the Russian Federation; Konstantin Kosachev, Chairman of the Committee of the Federation Council of the Russian Federation on International Affairs; Leonid Slutsky, Chairman of the Committee on International Affairs of the State Duma of the Russian Federation, Chairman of the Board of the International Public Fund "Russian Peace Foundation"; Ilya Timokhov, acting Deputy Director of the Information and Press Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia; Dr Jon-Hans Koetzer, representative of the United Nations Institute for Training and Research. Also, a welcoming address by Grigory Ordzhonikidze, Executive Secretary of the Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO, was read out.

The Expanded meeting of the General Council approved the Regulations on the Representative Office of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in the Republic of Bashkortostan. The General Council was attended by First Deputy Prime Minister of the Government of the Republic of Bashkortostan, special representative of the President of the Republic of Bashkortostan for investment cooperation Andrey Nazarov.

The Expanded meeting of the General Council heard speeches by: Svetozar Darnev, Chairman of the Audit Commission of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly; Alexander Ageev, Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Chairman of the Expert Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly on the activities of the Expert Council; Daria Saprinskiya, Chairman of the Coordinating Council of the Eurasian Youth Assembly, Deputy Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly on youth cooperation on the activities of the Eurasian Youth Assembly.

Members of the General Council addressed the meeting: Alexandra Ochirova, member of the General Council Presidium of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, member of the State Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO, UNESCO Goodwill Ambassador; Ivan Belekov, member of the State Duma Committee on CIS Affairs, Eurasian integration and relations with compatriots; Stanislav Korolev, Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly; Mikhail Balykhin, Chairman of the Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly for science and continuing education, rector of the Moscow State University of Food Production; Valery Ruzin, Chairman of the Council for film and video visualization of the cultural and historical space of Eurasia of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, President of the Eurasian Academy of television and radio.

General Council re-elected the co-Chairs of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly: Bernard Loze, Vice-President of the Association of French-Russian Dialogue (France); Dalbir Singh, National Secretary of the Indian National Congress, President of the Foundation for Policy and Governance (India); Igor Khalevinsky, Chairman of the Council of the Association of Russian Diplomats (Russia).

Cooperation agreements with new partners were signed at the Extended meeting of the General Council; new members of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly were solemnly awarded membership certificates.

September 4, Russia, Crimea, Sevastopol, online



An expanded meeting of the General Council Presidium of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly took place. Co-Chairs of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Dalbir Singh (India) and Bernard Loze (France), members of General Council Presidium Tolegen Mukhamedzhanov (Kazakhstan), Alexandra Ochirova (Russia), Ruben Safrastyan (Armenia), President of the Moscow Chamber of Commerce and Industry Suren Vardanyan and other friends and partners from different

regions of Russia and other countries of the world joined the meeting thanks to online technologies. Andrey Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, chaired the meeting. The First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat Svetlana Smirnova spoke about the main results and plans of the Assembly's activities.

November 26, Russia, Moscow, online

An expanded meeting of the General Council Presidium of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly took place. Representatives of 14 countries took part in the Presidium meeting. Following the meeting, the draft Activity Plan of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly for 2021 was approved. The educational project "EYA Lecture Hall" was assigned the status "Assembly - initiator / organizer". Traditionally, the Secretary General of the Assembly in a solemn atmosphere presented membership certificates to the new members of the organization. The Assembly and new partners signed cooperation agreements.

III. SIGNING AGREEMENTS WITH PARTNERS

January 31, Russia, Moscow



The international Union of non-governmental organizations «Eurasian Peoples' Assembly» signed an agreement on interaction and cooperation in the information sphere with the Federal state unitary enterprise «Information Telegraph Agency of Russia (ITAR-TASS)». The signing took place at an Expanded meeting of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. Secretary General Andrey Belyaninov signed the agreement for the Assembly, and First Deputy Director General Mikhail Gusman for TASS.

January 31, Russia, Moscow

Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and Chairman of the Eurasian Creative Guild (Great Britain) Mr John Farndon signed an agreement on cooperation of organizations at an Expanded meeting of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, held on January 31, 2020. The subject of the agreement was the implementation of cooperation and interaction in the humanitarian sphere. It is aimed at supporting public, state initiatives, events and actions for mutually beneficial international



cultural cooperation, uniting creative organizations and individuals of the Eurasian continent and the whole world.

January 31, Russia, Moscow



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly has concluded a cooperation agreement with the Russian-French Economic Chamber. The agreement was signed on the sidelines of an Expanded meeting of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation. On the part of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Secretary General Andrei Belyaninov, and on the part of the Russian-French Economic Chamber - by President Didier Chaudesaygue, signed the agreement. The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the

Russian-French Economic Chamber intend to further develop mutually beneficial cooperation on a long-term basis.

January 31, Russia, Moscow

Eurasian Peoples' Assembly signed with African cooperation agreement the Advisory Council. Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, and François Ndengwe, President of the African Advisory Council signed the agreement. The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly attaches great importance to the development of international communication platforms in order to establish and maintain a constructive dialogue between expert communities, public organizations and government agencies from African countries.



March 12, Russia, Moscow

Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the International Association of Capitals and Megacities (IAC) signed a cooperation agreement at the House of Nationalities. Moscow Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Assembly and Vladimir Selivanov, Peoples' Executive Vice President and Director General of the IAC signed the document. The agreement provides for cooperation between the parties in the field of trade, economic, scientific, technical and cultural development and cooperation between cities, regions and countries.



June 25, online

Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and High School Teachers European Society (HiSTES, Prague) signed agreement cooperation an on in education and science. It is planned to create a unified international social and educational platform. It will include a regular exchange experience and modern developments in education. advanced training, intensive interaction and ioint development of participants.



July 28, online



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Ricerca Senza Frontiere Association (Italy) signed a cooperation agreement. The agreement was signed by Svetlana Smirnova, First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and President of Ricerca Senza Frontiere Elena Repman. Cooperation involves interaction in science and education, culture and art, as well as project, information and grant activities.

According to previously agreed positions, the Association can represent the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly interests in the Republic of Italy, as well as initiate the organization of working groups with the involvement of national and international experts in order to implement specific projects and events. In addition, Ricerca Senza Frontiere will initiate accession to the Assembly of new members from Italy.

September 4, Russia, Crimea, Sevastopol

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Autonomous Non-Commercial Organization «Centre



for Support of Public Projects «Let's Do Together» signed an Agreement on Cooperation. The agreement was signed by Andrey Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, and Gennady Onishchenko, Chairman of the Coordinating Council of the «Let's Do It Together» movement. The Agreement provides for the establishment and development of long-term partnerships to organize joint work with children and youth in Eurasia.

October 7, Russia, Moscow



Secretary General of the Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and President of the Centre for Business Development and Cooperation with Russia Serge Phocas Odunlami (West Africa, Benin) signed a cooperation agreement. The text of the agreement noted the importance of the development of international communication platforms in order to establish and maintain a constructive dialogue with expert communities, public organizations and government agencies from African countries, as well as to convey an

objective and multilateral perception of the world.

October 12, Russia, Moscow



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the NOOSFERA Education Support Foundation signed a cooperation agreement. On behalf of the Assembly, the agreement was signed by the First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat Svetlana Smirnova, on behalf of NOOSPHERE - by the Director of the Foundation Sofya Arzumanyan. The partners plan interaction aimed at disseminating information about the history, cultural traditions of various peoples and the formation of a

culture of conscious tolerance among children and youth.

October 15, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Autonomous Non-Profit Organization «Institute of Diaspora and Integration» («Institute of the CIS Countries») signed a cooperation agreement. On behalf of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the agreement was signed by the First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat Svetlana Smirnova, on behalf of the Institute of CIS Countries - by its director Vladimir Egorov. The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Institute of the CIS countries plan to assist each other in developing relevant programs for the development of activities in international cooperation.

November 26, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the branch international Russian of the organization Women in Nuclear Russia / Foundation for the Development Professional Initiatives Women in the Nuclear Industry signed an agreement on cooperation. Secretary General of the Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and the President of the Foundation Alena Yakovleva put their signatures on the bilateral agreement.

The Head of Rossotrudnichestvo Yevgeny Primakov and the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov signed the agreement. The parties agreed on cooperation in science, culture, informational and humanitarian fields and development of social, business and scientific ties and initiatives.



December 11, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Board of Tax Consultants signed an agreement on international business cooperation. The parties agreed to jointly develop comprehensive trade,



economic, scientific and technical ties between organizations from different countries. The document was signed by Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations «Eurasian Peoples' Assembly» and Anton Zolotukhin, General Director of the Board of Tax Consultants LLC. The parties also agreed to facilitate the exchange of experience and information in the following areas: tourism, commercial and industrial environment, export,

import, finance, financial instruments, investment, innovation, state and public mechanisms to support entrepreneurs, measures to stimulate investment activity in Eurasian countries.

December 15, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the «Korean Business Council» Association of Entrepreneurs signed a cooperation agreement. The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and the Executive Director of the «Korean Business Council» Lilia Kulik. The partners plan to hold a session dedicated to cooperation with organizations in South Korea.



December 23, Russia, Moscow



Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and Chairman of the Commission of the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation on an accessible environment and the development of inclusive practices Diana Gurtskaya exchanged signed copies of a cooperation agreement between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the State Budgetary Institution "Centre for Socio-Cultural Rehabilitation of Diana Gurtskaya".

Andrey Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, and Yegor Kazakov, Director of the State Budgetary Institution "Centre for Socio-Cultural Rehabilitation of Diana Gurtskaya" signed the agreement.

December 24, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Union of Women's Forces to Support Civil Initiatives Projects signed an agreement cooperation. The parties agreed to jointly implement socially significant programs, projects and cultural and educational events in the field of international cooperation. Secretary General of the Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and the General Director of the Union Inga Legasova signed the agreement.



December 24, Russia, Moscow



Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and the General Director of the Non-Governmental Environmental Fund named after Vernadsky Olga Plamina signed an agreement on cooperation between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Non-Governmental and the Ecological Fund named after V.I. Vernadsky. The goals of cooperation are to achieve sustainable environmentally oriented socioeconomic development of society and its

responsible attitude to the natural and cultural heritage of the countries of the Eurasian space. The document became a logical continuation of the working relations of two organizations.

December 28, Russia, Moscow, St. Petersburg, online



An agreement on cooperation was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations **«Eurasian** Peoples' Assembly» and the Research Foundation «Digital History». The agreement is aimed at preserving the historical memory of the Second World War and the Great Patriotic War, preventing attempts to rehabilitate Nazism, protecting the historical and memorial heritage of the Second World War and the Great Patriotic War, as well as increasing the

role of public (people's) diplomacy in ensuring trust and mutual understanding among the peoples of different countries. The parties agreed to jointly implement socially significant programs, projects and cultural, educational, educational, scientific events in the field of international cooperation. The agreement was signed by Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, and Yegor Yakovlev, Director of the «Digital History» Research Foundation.

IV. REPRESENTATIVE AND WORKING MEETINGS

January 16, Russia, Moscow



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly held a meeting with the rector of Genghis Khan International University, Honorary Teacher of Mongolia Namsray Nyam-Osor and the first vice-rector of Genghis Khan International University, Professor Zhambal Tsetsegmaa. Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Mikhail Fedorov presented the heads of the Mongolian university with Letters of Thanks for their help in organizing the Assembly Days in Mongolia, which took place in Ulan Bator in 2019.

During the meeting, the participants discussed the issues of cooperation in the field of secondary and professional education, participation of the Mongolian University in the work of the Council for Science and Continuing Education of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. Special attention was focused on the participation of the Mongolian University in the International Megaproject of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER - for Peace and Creation» dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the Victory. As a result of the meeting, the parties agreed to sign a Cooperation Agreement between the Assembly and Genghis Khan International University.

February 19, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly held a meeting with representatives of the Embassy of the Republic of Mauritius - Chargé d'Affaires Mr Yanmajizing Bissundoyal and economic advisor Mr Upendranath Amoru. During the negotiations, agreements were reached a Memorandum of Cooperation signing between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Embassy of the Republic of Mauritius. It is planned to implement joint projects in the field of culture, education, economy and tourism. The parties supported a mutual initiative on the possibility of holding the Days of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly on the territory of the Republic of Mauritius in 2021.



September 23, Russia, Moscow



The Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov met with the Executive Secretary of the Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO Grigory Ordzhonikidze. The parties discussed the issues of cooperation and the possibility of new joint projects. «Today we discussed possible topics and format of events under the patronage of the Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO. We are ready to further cooperation, including in a global project on scientific

diplomacy initiated by the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly», - said Grigory Ordzhonikidze. The meeting also noted important aspects of successful cooperation - openness and support for new ideas. The headquarters of the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC) in Moscow hosted a working meeting of the First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Svetlana Smirnova and Director of the Protocol and Organizational Support Department, Chairman of the **EEC** Youth Council Daniyar Turusbekov. The meeting participants considered proposals for filling the program of

cooperation between the EEC and the Assembly for 2021, the Assembly's proposal for the introduction of observer status with the EEC, as well as the initiative of the EEC Youth Council to create the EAEU Youth Council. The parties confirmed the intention to interact on a wide range of issues: from cultural and sports events to support for public and youth projects within the EAEU. It was noted that possible cooperation could develop within the implementation of the provisions of the Strategic Directions for the Development of Eurasian Economic Integration until 2025.

December 24, Russia, Moscow

Vernadsky Olga Plamina. The organizations will implement projects consistent with the goals of sustainable, environmentally oriented socio-economic development of society, its responsible attitude to the natural and cultural heritage of the countries of the Eurasian space.



December 28, Russia, Moscow

V. FORUMS, CONFERENCES, ROUNDTABLE MEETINGS

January 30, Russia, Moscow

November 2-3, Russia, Crimea, Sevastopol, online



June 8, Russia, Moscow



April 15, online

of the project is to remind people of human life as the highest value. The International Mugham Centre is actively expanding its international contacts with institutions and cultural organizations of a number of foreign countries. As part of the dissemination of mugham and national music, the centre hosts cultural events, lectures and online projects, and is currently working to organize international online conferences

October, France, Lille



In France, a unique exhibition of Alexander Khimushin "The World in Faces" has opened as part of the project "All Colours of Eurasia" (project manager Galina Druon), held annually with the support of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The unique photos show people from all over our vast planet. Quarantine measures could have prevented, but the painstaking work of the exhibition organizer Tatiana Lambolez continued throughout the year and the photographs arrived in France in

early autumn. As planned, the vernissage took place in the large university of the city of Lille.

November 2, Russia, Udmurtia

The presentation of the book-album "Traditional Udmurt Wedding" took place in the Ludorvai Architectural and Ethnographic Museum-Reserve. The book was published as part of the celebration of the 100th anniversary of Udmurtia. It is a part of the project "Weddings of the peoples of the world: cultural heritage". "The presentation of the traditions of Udmurt culture, in particular, wedding traditions at the UN headquarters in New York in 2021, is currently being discussed," - said Denis Knyazev, founder



and head of the project "World Weddings: Cultural Heritage". The author works on the continuation of the project, on the book about a traditional Nenets wedding.

On November 10, as part of the project "World Weddings: Cultural Heritage", an online meeting was held with the participation of the Chairman of the Public Council of the Arctic Zone of Russia, a member of the Federation Council from the Yamal-Nenets Autonomous Okrug Grigory Ledkov and First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Svetlana Smirnova.

November, Russia, Moscow

A Project Office has been established in the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. A special section has appeared on the official website of the Assembly. Now members and partners of the organization will be able to learn about the Assembly's initiatives to promote and implement projects. The new section "Project Office" will publish relevant materials for the non-profit sector, as well as on the implementation and preparation of projects in various areas, including socially significant and educational.



In 2020, the team of the Assembly's Project Office won a grant from the Presidential Grants Foundation for the implementation of the innovative project "Lessons in Journalism for the Blind" children, aimed at teaching children with disabilities the basics of journalism in the current difficult conditions of the pandemic.

The Assembly's Project Office is open for partnerships, ready to advise and share its capabilities in practice. In addition, a professional team works with business donors, private donations, public funds, and grant competitions.

IX. INTERNATIONAL MEGAPROJECT «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER - IN THE NAME OF PEACE AND CREATION»

In the Year of Memory and Glory, the Assembly implements the International Megaproject «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER – in the name of Peace and Creation». It includes public initiatives in various countries of Eurasia aimed at preserving the memory of the Great Patriotic War and the Second World War.

February 7, Russia, Moscow



Roundtable meeting «Meeting on the Elbe – 75», dedicated to the anniversary of the historic meeting of the Soviet and Allied forces and the End of World War II, was held at the Russian House of International Scientific and Technical Cooperation. The meeting was supported by of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. In the Year of remembrance and glory the Assembly is implementing the International megaproject «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER - for Peace and

Creation». It includes projects aimed at preserving the memory of the Great Patriotic War and World War II in various countries of Eurasia.

February 14, Russia, Crimea, Yalta



The Livadia Palace in Crimea hosted the Yalta International Public Forum on Preserving the Memory of the Second World War and the Great **Patriotic** War **«VICTORIOUS** TOGETHER – for Peace and Creation». It was attended by representatives of the Federation Council of the Russian Federation, the State Council of the Republic of Crimea, as well as the Historical Perspective Foundation, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio, Association of Researchers of Russian Society and other public organizations. Moderators -

Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and Artem Berezovsky, representative of the Russian Foreign Ministry in Simferopol made greeting speeches. Taking as a basis the unique lessons of history, the International Public Forum unites the efforts of the authorities and society to replace the old destructive scenarios of wars and conflicts with new peaceful forms of coexistence of peoples. Scientists, public figures, representatives of international intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations, government bodies, youth organizations, and the media attended the event. The Livadia Declaration on the maintenance of peace and security was adopted at the International Public Forum. Following the results of the forum, a collection of reports was published.

April 24, online



Eurasian Peoples' Assembly together with its partners organized and held the International teleconference «Meeting on the Elbe - 75». Historians and reenactors, public figures and politicians, scientists and businessmen from Armenia, Belarus, Bulgaria, Great Britain, Germany. Georgia, Denmark. Kazakhstan, Canada, China, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, the Netherlands, United Arab Emirates. Poland, Russia. Serbia. USA. Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, France,

Estonia participated in the teleconference. More than 1000 people from 40 countries were able to watch the live broadcast on social networks.

The International Teleconference was held in order to remind of the the allies victory in the Second World War, draw the attention of general public to the issues of preserving historical memory, countering attempts to rehabilitate Nazism, and also suggest new ideas for saving the planet from wars, climatic and other threats. More than 30 speakers were able to speak at the online conference. They raised topics about the lessons of the Second World War, the meaning of the meeting on the Elbe 75 years later, the possibility and necessity of cooperation in the name of peace and creation. As a result of the international teleconference, an appeal was drawn up by the participants to the heads of States, international intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations, and to all people of goodwill. Information about the International teleconference «Meeting on the Elbe – 75» is posted in Russian, American, German and Latvian media.

May 1 - 9, online



An online music marathon dedicated to the 75th anniversary of Victory «Music of the Victory» was held with the assistance of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The organizers of the event aimed to set a record for the most mass performance of the popular Russian song «Victory Day». More than 12 thousand people including the countries of Eurasia applied for and participated in the marathon. More than five million viewers from different countries watched the mass performance

of the song. On May 8 the festive program «Field of Miracles» on Channel One (Russia) gave a nationwide start for setting records. The official YouTube channel of the marathon was opened. The participants' videos were shown for 24 hours. On May 9, the registration of two Russian Records was solemnly announced. Also, the number of musicians and vocalists who took part in the music marathon was indicated.

May 5, online

The Foundation of the First President of the Republic of Kazakhstan – Elbasy together with the Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio held an international presentation of the book «Panfilovites: Our Pride, Our Glory» by Laila Akhmetova, a member of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Doctor of Historical Sciences, Professor of the Al-Farabi Kazakhstan National University.



The book was published in Almaty in 1000 copies. The presentation was moderated by the Director of the Central State Archive of Kazakhstan Arnur Karymsakov and Chairman of the Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly on film and video visualization of the cultural and historical space of Eurasia, President of the Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio Valery Ruzin.

May 9, online



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly held an International videoconference with partners: «The USSR: VICTORIOUS TOGETHER - for Peace and Creation».

The videoconference was opened by Yuri Anufriev, President of the Foundation «Eurasians – a New Wave», Svetlana Smirnova, First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples'

Assembly, Nikolay Udovichenko, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Russian Federation to Kyrgyzstan, and Eduard Lozansky, President of the American University in Moscow, Professor at Moscow state University.

Representatives of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Estonia, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Russia, Uzbekistan, Ukraine, Tajikistan, and Turkmenistan attended the videoconference.

The international event brought together well-known historians and scientists, public and political figures from the former republics of the Soviet Union and other countries. The forum was dedicated to the preservation of historical memory and the inadmissibility of fuelling regional conflicts and other negative manifestations. The participants called for preserving peace, friendship and harmony, as well as for effective cooperation between countries and peoples.

June 17, online

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio and the Association of Russian Society Researchers (AIRO-XXI) held an online International Public Forum to preserve the memory of the Second World War and the Great Patriotic War as part of the Megaproject «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER – for Peace and Creation».



The theme of the Forum was «Be worthy of the memory of the fallen». Representatives of all 15 former Soviet Union republics attended the forum. The International Public Forum was held for the fourth time. The initiative, born in Sevastopol, united the forum participants in a continuous dialogue and became an effective tool and a real platform for cooperation between representatives of the international community. The purpose of the forum was to draw the attention of the general public to the issues of preserving historical memory, countering attempts to rehabilitate Nazism.

The Forum «Be worthy of the memory of the fallen» lasted about two hours and was divided into three blocks. In the first block, the participants discussed the question of how to resist attempts to destroy the common contribution of the Soviet peoples to the victory in the Great Patriotic War, what to do so that time does not really have power over sacred memory. The second block was dedicated to the upcoming Day of Remembrance and Sorrow, June 22, the day of the beginning of the Great Patriotic War. Forum participants talked about how this day will be marked in different countries and regions. «Is it possible to preserve the real memory of the anti-Hitler coalition with a lie, with the assertion of the superiority of one country over other states; is it possible to preserve the unity of people, Europe, the world in this way?» - this question became the leitmotif of the third block of the forum.

June 22, online



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly held an International Commemorative Action as a sign of respect for the well-known and unknown heroes of the Great Patriotic War. The Action took place as part of the Megaproject «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER – for Peace and Creation». The purpose of the action is to show that the memory of one of the most tragic pages in the history of the 20th century will forever remain in the hearts of people who lived together in a united country, who went through

all the hardships of a terrible war, survived and won. The action started from Dubosekov, Volokolamsk district of the Moscow region and was held in an online format. At about 4 a.m. Moscow time, participants – representatives of the cities of Eurasia and 15 former Soviet republics lit candles and laid flowers at the monuments and tombs of the war heroes in their countries, cities and villages. The online meeting took place at exactly 4:00 a.m. using the Zoom platform. The live broadcast was held on the Facebook account of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. After a minute of silence, the organizers showed a video clip specially prepared for June 22. Photos and videos were sent in advance.

August 27 – September 4, Russia, Crimea, Sevastopol

The Sevastopol International Festival of Documentary Films and TV Programs "VICTORIOUS TOGETHER" was dedicated to the 75th anniversary of Victory in the Great Patriotic War. The organizers of the Festival are the Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio, the Government of Sevastopol, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the Council for Film and Video Visualization of the Cultural and Historical Space of Eurasia. Despite the policy of sanctions, 2020 was in many ways a record year for the festival: more than 1000 applications were received to participate in the competitive screenings. XVI Sevastopol International Festival of Documentary Films and TV Programs "VICTORIOUS TOGETHER" has confirmed its status as the largest in Russia. In the competition programs of the XVI Festival, 144 films from 35 countries and 22 regions of Russia were shown, and 24 in non-competition ones.



Among the contestants were both debutants and famous names. The festival program included the National Documentary Film Competition and four International Competition: Documentary Film Competition, Television Competition, Film Schools Competition and for the first time - Social Film, Video and Advertising Competition. Two thematic blocks were presented in the International Competition of Documentary Films: "MEMORY" "REFLECTION". Italian directors

Manzolini and Federico Ferrone awarded the Grand Prix to the film "The Transition".

Expressing gratitude to medical workers, the directorate of the XVI Sevastopol International Festival of Documentary Films and TV Programs "VICTORIOUS TOGETHER" has prepared a special program of screenings of documentaries about the daily exploits of doctors - "Thank you, Doctor", based on the film of the same name by a young director from Kyrgyzstan Adilet Karzhoev, laureate of the XV Sevastopol Festival "VICTORIOUS TOGETHER» in 2017. At the XVI Sevastopol International Festival of Documentary Films and TV Programs "VICTORIOUS TOGETHER" program "Thank you, Doctor!" got its sequel as a special event.

September 4, Russia, Crimea, Sevastopol



The awarding ceremony of the participants of the XVI International Festival of Documentary Films and TV Programs «VICTORIOUS TOGETHER» took place in Sevastopol, in the cinema «Russia». 

The 6th Session of the International Public Forum "Preserving the Memory of the Second World War and the Great Patriotic War" was held in the "House of Friendship of the Leningrad Region" in St. Petersburg and the Museum "Road of Life" in Vsevolozhsk. Forum organizers: Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio, Research Foundation "Digital History".

The Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Doctor of Economics, Doctor of

Political Science Andrei Belyaninov and Director of the State Budgetary Institution of Leningrad Region "House of Friendship" Vladimir Mikhailenko greeted the participants. Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, President of the Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio Valery Ruzin and Director of the Digital History Research Foundation Yegor Yakovlev moderated the Forum.

The main goal of the Forum is to consolidate scientists studying the issues of the genocide of the Soviet people by Nazi Germany during the 1941-1945 war, and to make their scientific discoveries available to the general public. During the 6th Session, facts were made public, indicating the existence of a framework plan for the leadership of Nazi Germany for the mass destruction of the peoples of the Soviet Union. The participants appealed to the General Prosecutor's Office and the Investigative Committee of Russia with the initiative to start an investigation into the actions of the Nazis in the occupied territories of the USSR and recognize them as genocide of the population of the USSR.

X. INTERNATIONAL PROJECT EURASIA KIDS

The humanitarian project EURASIA KIDS is aimed at the comprehensive development of children and expanding their opportunities in the future. It brings together a number of initiatives related to the purpose of intensifying information and cultural exchange based on network connections and personal contacts among children from different countries of the Eurasian continent. Project manager is Olga Chirkova, a journalist, teacher and initiator of a number of social projects.

February 21, Russia, Udmurtia, Izhevsk

An inclusive school of African drums was opened as part of the EURASIA KIDS project. The first lessons of playing a traditional instrument of African peoples were received by the guys from the rehabilitation centre for children and adolescents with disabilities «Adeli». Friendship of «special» children and musicians from Africa began a year ago at the celebration dedicated to International Children's Day. African drums were played for the first time at the Noise Orchestra site. The idea to


The conference included youth session, student reports, a poetry competition held with the active participation of the Eurasian Youth Assembly. The conference discussed a wide

November 10, Russia, Moscow, online


