I. KEY RESULTS OF THE EURASIAN PEOPLES'ASSEMBLY ACTIVITY 2021

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly is an International Union of Non-governmental Organizations and citizens with an active life position, sharing and promoting the ideas and values of Eurasian integration, the protection of peace, the strengthening of friendship, harmony, partnership and good-neighborliness between peoples. It is these ideas and values that are today top-priority issues on the international agenda for the salvation of the common future of humanity.

On July 9, 2021, Moscow hosted the General Eurasian Peoples' Assembly - the general meeting of Assembly members, the supreme body of the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly". The event was supported by the UN Information Center and held at the site of the main information partner - TASS.

The General Assembly summed up the organization's activities since its establishment, approved a long-term plan for the next four years, and elected the governing bodies of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. Andrey Yuryevich Belyaninov was re-elected General Secretary of the Assembly.

Having summed up the results of the first stage of development, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly continues to develop as an international platform, affirming the ideology of peace, benevolent good-neighborliness between different countries and peoples.

By the end of the reporting period more than 845 individuals and legal entities, representatives of non-governmental organizations from 53 countries are members of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly.

Despite the restrictions associated with the pandemic the program of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly activities for 2021 includes activities aimed at strengthening integration processes through diversified cooperation with partners from different countries of Greater Eurasia.

A number of events organized by the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly were supported by UNESCO and the UN Information Center.

In March 2021, the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" was nominated for the Félix Houphouët-Boigny UNESCO Peace Prize as the organization meeting all the criteria for a high-level prize.

Among the priority areas of public diplomacy of the Assembly in the reporting period it is worth to highlight:

- Youth diplomacy. Projects for children and youth.
- Scientific and educational diplomacy. Projects in education and science.
- Cultural and humanitarian diplomacy. Projects dedicated to common history, spiritual and moral values, the promotion of a unifying Russian language, cultural exchanges and humanitarian security.
- Economic cooperation. Partnership based on trust, common views on the achievements of culture, science, striving for peace and economic integration.
 - Happiness Diplomacy has become a new activity area.

In 2021, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly created the Department of Happiness. Its main tasks include activities on organizing cooperation in achieving sustainable development goals to increase the happiness index in Eurasian countries, generalization and replication of successful international experience and the development of charitable programs. Support of public and state initiatives aimed at creating conditions for the public and personal happiness of the peoples of Eurasia becomes one of the most important criteria of the state authority in the international arena. Among the tasks is the creation of additional opportunities and favorable conditions for people and organizations striving to make a creative contribution to the development of Eurasia for a happy life of all its peoples.

Despite the difficult, acute situation with the coronavirus pandemic, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly continues to expand interaction with partners from different countries, both offline and online, since many emerging global problems can only be solved together.

During the reporting period, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly concluded 36 cooperation agreements with partners. In general, since its establishment, the Assembly has signed agreements with more than 135 business organizations, chambers of commerce and industry, higher educational institutions, foundations, scientific centers, various public organizations and associations from India, France, Serbia, Greece, Syria, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Turkey, Bulgaria, Russia, Azerbaijan, England, Italy, Spain, Benin and other countries.

The establishment in 2021 of two Committees of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly became positive and efficient. The Committee on Science and Education develops in the area of scientific diplomacy and is aimed at creating conditions for enhancing cooperation between academic institutions operating within the Eurasian space and non-academic organizations around the world relating their activities at the promotion of educational and scientific projects in the interests of strengthening peace and safety.

The activities of the Greater Eurasia - Africa International Committee are focused on establishing strong mutually beneficial partnership relations between the peoples of Eurasia and Africa using the tools of public diplomacy. During the reporting period a number of agreements were signed and such major events as an International Round Table "Eurasia - Africa: Connecting Continents. Priorities and Synergy of Cooperation" and the Round Table "Greater Eurasia - Africa": Sustainable Development and Social Responsibility" were held.

An important Assembly activity area has been and remains the promotion of the UN Sustainable Development Goals implementation.

The most relevant to the Assembly goal is to strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the Global Partnership for Sustainable Development.

Successful implementation of the sustainable development agenda is impossible without building partnerships between governments and civil society in Eurasia, without common goals focused on the interests of all mankind and the planet.

THE MAIN GOAL OF THE EURASIAN PEOPLES' ASSEMBLY is the formation of a social integration model in the name of establishing peace and harmony through the development of multilateral cooperation and public (people's) diplomacy.

- Development of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly as an important tool of public diplomacy and enhancing its role in the context of the formation of a multipolar world

- The unity of the peoples of Eurasia and the upbringing of the younger generation on basic spiritual and moral values common to all mankind

- Joining efforts to preserve the Eurasian continent in all the diversity of its natural, spiritual, cultural, historical heritage and create safe and comfortable living conditions
- Introduction of new formats of interaction and creation of an effective partnership of the Assembly with civil society institutions and authorities of Eurasian countries
- Development and implementation of programs, projects and events related to the Assembly statutory activities and aimed at strengthening cooperation between the peoples of Eurasia
- Creation of opportunities and favorable conditions for using the resource potential of every person striving to make his own creative contribution to the development of Eurasia

I. MEETINGS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE GENERAL COUNCIL AND THE GENERAL COUNCIL PRESIDIUM

The General Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the general meeting of all Assembly members, is the supreme body of the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly".

January 28, online

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly held an extraordinary meeting of the General Assembly. The meeting was broadcast live on the Assembly's official Facebook account. During the meeting, it was decided that the next reporting and election General Eurasian Peoples' Assembly will be held in the Republic of Bashkortostan on July 9, 2021. A number of new projects of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly were also considered and approved. It was decided to approve October 18 the Day of Spiritual Harmony of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in support of the initiative of Kazakhstan.



July 9, Russia, Moscow, online



Moscow hosted the General Eurasian Peoples' Assembly - a general meeting of all members of the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly". In order to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus infection, the meeting was held mainly in an online format. Thanks to the live broadcast and the hybrid format of the meeting, Assembly members from 45 countries of the world took part in it. More than 12 thousand viewers watched the broadcast of the meeting on the platforms

of TASS, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the TV Company "Mir".

The General Assembly summed up the results of the Assembly's activities since its establishment, approved a long-term plan for the next four years, and elected the governing bodies of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly.

The meeting approved the regulations on the new structures of the organization - the Supreme Advisory Council and the Media Council. They included reputable international public, political and state leaders, representatives of business, industrial and financial circles, and the media.

The General Assembly received greetings from President of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin, Chairman of the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation Valentina Matvienko, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Russia Sergey Lavrov, UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres, Director General of UNESCO Audre Azoulay, Chairman of the Executive Committee - Executive Secretary of the Commonwealth of Independent States Sergey Lebedev, Deputy Chief of Staff of the Presidential Administration of the Russian Federation Dmitry Kozak, Chairman of the State Duma Committee on International Affairs, Chairman of the Board of the International Public Foundation "Russian Peace Foundation" Leonid Slutsky, Chairman of the Committee on Issues of Nationalities of the State Duma of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation Valery Gazzaev, Deputy Chairman of the Assembly of the People of Kazakhstan, Head of the Secretariat of the Assembly of the People of Kazakhstan of the Administration of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan of Marat Azilkhanov and other officials.



UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres expressed his sincere sympathy and support to the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, and warm wishes for health, peace, well-being and prosperity to its inspirers and delegations.

Vladimir Kuznetsov, Director of the UN Information Center in Moscow, Representative of the UN Secretary General, conveyed the greetings of the UN Secretary General at the General Eurasian Peoples' Assembly.

The General Assembly was attended by: Deputy Chairman of the Federation Council of the Russian Federation Konstantin Kosachev, Director of the UN Information Center in Moscow Vladimir Kuznetsov, Executive Secretary of the Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO Grigory Ordzhonikidze, Member of the Board (Minister) for Integration and Macroeconomics of the EEC Sergey Glazyev, Director of the FAO Office for Liaison with the Russian Federation Oleg Kobyakov, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka to the Russian Federation Professor Migaaland D. Lamawansa, Deputy Head of the diplomatic mission, Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan in the Russian Federation, Mr. Summer Javed.

The Assembly Secretary General Andrei Belyaninov presented Alexandra Ochirova, Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Goodwill Ambassador of UNESCO (Russia) with the Eurasian Recognition Award "THE ENVOY OF AMITY" for her significant contribution to strengthening friendship and peace between peoples. In 2021, the 'THE ENVOY OF AMITY" Award was also presented to Anatoly Karpov, multiple World Chess Champion, President of the International Association of Peace Foundations (Russia); Olzhas Suleimenov, Co-Chairman of the Council of Elders of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Director of the International Centre for the Rapprochement of Cultures under the auspices of UNESCO in Almaty, People's Writer of Kazakhstan (Kazakhstan); Andres Santana Arribas, Head of the International University Centre for East Europe and Central Asia and the Pushkin Institute at the University of Cadiz (Spain), Didier Chaudesaygues, President of the Russian-French Economic Chamber (France), and François Ndengwe, Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Chairman of the African Advisory Board (AAB) (Cameroon).

The medals of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly "For Contribution to Peace" were awarded to the three Co-Chairmen of the General Council of the Assembly: Chairman of the Council of the Association of Russian Diplomats Igor Khalevinsky (Russia), Vice-President of the Franco-Russian Dialogue Association Bernard Loze (France) and President of the Foundation for Policy and Governance Dalbir Singh (India).

In the period between General Assemblies, the General Council is the Assembly Collegial executive body that implements the assigned tasks. The General Council of the Assembly includes well-known public figures from 33 countries of Greater Eurasia.

July 16, Russia, Moscow, online

The first meeting of the new General Council of the Eurasian Peoples 'Assembly, elected on July 9 at the General Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, took place.

Representatives of non-governmental public organizations from 33 countries were elected to the General Council: Austria, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Benin, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Vietnam, Germany, Georgia, Denmark, Egypt, Iran, Spain, Italy, Kazakhstan, Cameroon, China, Kyrgyzstan, Lithuania,



Macedonia, Moldova, Palestine, Russia, Serbia, Slovenia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Finland, France, Montenegro, Czech Republic, Switzerland. Also, Deputy Secretaries General and Co-Chairman of the General Council were elected. The meeting has determined the composition of the Supreme Advisory Council and the Council of Elders of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly

May 27, online



An extended online meeting of the General Council Presidium of the of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly took place. It was chaired by Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The meeting was attended by members of the Presidium from India, Serbia, Russia, Kazakhstan, Bulgaria, France, Azerbaijan, Korea, Finland. The main issue on the agenda was the discussion of issues related to the holding of the upcoming reporting and election General Eurasian Peoples' Assembly.

II. SIGNING AGREEMENTS WITH PARTNERS

January 28, online



An agreement was signed on cooperation between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the University of Cadiz (Kingdom of Spain). The parties agreed to cooperate on programs of volunteering and education, including the older generation, as well as the joint organization of international events aimed at the development of public initiatives in Europe and Asia.

January 28, online

An agreement on cooperation between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the International Union of Charitable and Humanitarian Public Associations "Soviet Peace Foundation" was signed. The parties agreed to cooperate in order to strengthen international relations aimed at supporting public peacemaking initiatives, promoting spiritual and moral education of youth, implementing socially significant programs, projects, cultural, educational and sporting events.



February 4, Russia, Moscow



A cooperation agreement was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the International Eurasian Association of Trade Unions and their Associations (EAP). The purpose of the agreement is to expand international business cooperation and exchange of experience and information. In particular, the development of a system of international professional training institutions that promotes the social and legal qualifications of migrant

workers and the creation of a civilizational professional labor market for migrants in the Eurasian space.

February 11, Russia, Moscow

A cooperation agreement was signed between the Non-Governmental International Union of Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the Charitable Foundation "Give the Good to the World". The parties agreed on interaction aimed at joint implementation of socially significant programs and related to inclusion, and deepening partnerships between peoples of different countries, including the exchange of experiences developments in the field of new inclusive methodologies.



February 11, Russia, Moscow



A cooperation agreement was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the Interregional Public Organization "Association for Assistance to Citizens of Closed Administrative-Territorial Entities of the Russian Ministry of Defense.

Given the growing role of integration processes on the Eurasian continent, recognizing the important role of NGOs in the socio-economic development of Eurasia,

and attaching importance to the development of international communication platforms in order to establish and maintain business cooperation between organizations and companies from Eurasia, the parties agreed to implement joint projects aimed at expanding and strengthening international business cooperation.

February 18, Russia, Moscow

An agreement on cooperation was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the Association "International Association of Graduates of the Higher Komsomol School at the Central Committee of Komsomol".

The parties agreed on interaction aimed at deepening partnerships between peoples of different countries; increasing the role of public diplomacy to ensure trust



and understanding between nations; development of international relations to support public, state, peacemaking initiatives; joint implementation of socially significant programs, projects and cultural, educational and business activities in the field of international cooperation; joining efforts to develop friendship and partnership relations.

February 24, Russia, Moscow



A cooperation agreement was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and Open Joint-Stock Company "FinanceCreditBank".

The purpose of the agreement is to expand and strengthen international business cooperation and exchange of experience and information in the following areas: tourism, trade and industrial environment, export, import, finance, financial

instruments, investment, innovation, state and public mechanisms to support entrepreneurs, measures to stimulate investment activity of Eurasia.

February 26, Russia, Moscow



An agreement was signed on cooperation between the of Non-Governmental International Union Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the Regional Public Organization "Indian Diaspora" Association of Indians. The parties agreed to promote international relations based on multifaceted cooperation and cultural values; to hold joint events, including forums, scientific and practical conferences, round tables, meetings, seminars, and discussion platforms; share experience and to

organizational and informational support to each other.

March 4, 2021, Russia, Moscow

March 4, 2021 International Union of NGOs "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the non-profit partnership "International Center for the Development of Social Projects" Holy Lavra of Russia the Orthodox "have signed a cooperation agreement. As part of the agreement, the parties are considering the possibility of joint implementation of socially significant programs, projects and cultural and educational activities in the sphere of international



cooperation. In addition, the organizations intend to promote multilateral relations in all spheres of public life, using the unique integrative potential of public diplomacy.

March 17, Russia, Moscow



The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Autonomous Non-Commercial Organization "Center for Humanitarian Development" signed a cooperation agreement. The ceremony was held on March 11 at the headquarters of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in Moscow during a large online meeting of the leaders of the Assembly's partner organizations from different countries.

The document was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and Director of the International Center for Humanitarian Development Dmitry Nersesyan.

The objectives of this agreement are to expand and strengthen international business cooperation, as well as exchange accumulated experience and information in the following areas: tourism, commercial and industrial environment, export, import, finance, financial instruments, investments, innovations, state and public mechanisms to support entrepreneurs, incentive measures investment activity of the countries of Eurasia.

April 13, Russia, Moscow



The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the Coordinating Committee for Economic Cooperation with African Countries (AFROCOM/AFROCOM) signed an agreement on cooperation. The agreement provides for the expansion and strengthening of international business cooperation, including the pooling of organizations' efforts in the African direction.

April 16, Russia, Astrakhan

The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia" and the Association "Center for International and Socio-Political Research "Caspian-Eurasia" signed a cooperation agreement.

The parties agreed to cooperate aimed at developing international integration relations, supporting public, state and peacemaking initiatives. In particular, to jointly implement socially important programs,



educational projects and cultural and educational activities in the field of international cooperation, deepening partnerships between peoples of different countries and increasing the role of public diplomacy to ensure trust and understanding between nations.

April 16, Russia, Astrakhan



An agreement on cooperation was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of Eurasian Nations" and the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Astrakhan State Technical University". The parties agreed to develop cooperation, using the unique integration potential of public diplomacy, a system of equal international partnership, exchange of experience and dialogue.

April 20, Russia, Moscow

A cooperation agreement was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasia Assembly" and the UNESCO Club "International Children's Congress". Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Assembly of Peoples of Eurasia, and Vladimir Viquious, President of the UNESCO Club "International Children's Congress", signed the bilateral agreement.



May 29, Russia, Moscow



At the Tchaikovsky Moscow State Conservatory, Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Assembly of Peoples of Eurasia, was admitted to the World Musketeer Society. An agreement on cooperation between the two organizations was signed.

June 5, Russia, St. Petersburg

On the fourth day of the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum (SPIEF-2021), the Ministry of Digital Development of the Kaluga Region, the Roscongress Foundation and the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" signed a cooperation agreement. The parties plan to work together to create and support the work in the Kaluga region of the Support Center for socially significant projects and initiatives in using artificial intelligence and working with data.



June 15, Russia, Khanty-Mansiysk



The Government of the Khanty-Mansiysk Autonomous Okrug - Yugra and the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly signed an agreement on cooperation at the XII International IT Forum with the participation of the BRICS and SCO countries held in Khanty-Mansiysk (KhMAO-Yugra, Russia). The parties plan to develop the trade and economic potential of the Autonomous Okrug and the Eurasian states, strengthen business and public relations, communication platforms,

humanitarian, business, industrial, technological, scientific and technical, investment cooperation.

June 29, Russia, Moscow

At the headquarters of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in Moscow, a cooperation agreement was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the All-Russian public organization "Association of Russian Lawyers".

The subject of the agreement is the establishment of partnerships, the expansion and strengthening of international business cooperation, as well as the



exchange of accumulated experience and information, solving socially significant problems, raising the level of legal culture and legal education of citizens.

July 27, Russia, Moscow



The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Union of Arab Universities signed a cooperation agreement.

Agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and the Secretary General of the Association of Arab Universities Amr Ezzat Salam within a meeting of rectors of Russian and Arab universities in Moscow at

M.V. Lomonosov Moscow State University (Russia). The subject of the agreement is the establishment of partnerships, the expansion and strengthening of international business cooperation, as well as the exchange of accumulated experience and information, the solution of socially significant tasks related primarily to the sphere of accessibility of education for representatives of the countries of Eurasia.

July 28, Russia, Belgorod

The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Council of Rectors of Higher Educational Institutions of the Belgorod Region signed a cooperation agreement. The subject of the agreement is the expansion and strengthening of scientific and educational cooperation, as well as the exchange of experience and information on issues related to the development of scientific and educational ties and international cultural and humanitarian cooperation.



July 28, Russia, Belgorod



The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Association of Foreign Graduates of Universities of the Central and Southern Regions of the Country "International Commonwealth" signed a cooperation agreement. Within the agreement, the parties plan to organize joint bilateral and multilateral events, develop and implement educational and educational programs, assist in improving long-term and comprehensive

educational, scientific and technical ties between organizations and universities of different countries on the basis of reciprocity, and participate in joint practical projects.

August 12, Russia, Kaluga



At the forum "Digital Evolution", the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly", the All-Russian Public Movement "People's Front "For Russia", the Public Movement "Inspirers", the Ministry of Digital Development of the Kaluga Region, the Department of Digital Development of the Belgorod Region and the Ministry of Digital Development and Communications Saratov region signed a multilateral open agreement on cooperation in


The subject of the agreement is, in particular, the promotion of the preservation of the historical memory of the heroism of people in the fight against fascism

The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov and



February 4, Russia, Moscow




April 27, Russia, Moscow

October 7, Kyrgyzstan, Bishkek








V. FORUMS, CONFERENCES, ROUND TABLES

The Assembly focuses on issues of economic cooperation, priorities in the field of culture, sports, education, youth policy. The annual activity program of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly includes events aimed at strengthening integration processes through diversified cooperation with partners from different countries of Greater Eurasia.

February 10, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly held an online International Roundtable "Greater Eurasia-Africa: Sustainable Development and Social Responsibility".

April 6, online



between the two traditionally close countries were discussed.

As a result, recommendations were formed that aim to convey to the widest possible range of participants in bilateral relations the information about key trends in their development.

The materials of the Round Table were translated into 6 languages - Vietnamese, English, Spanish, French, Chinese, Russian and then sent to partners.





At the initiative of the Committee of the State Duma of the Russian Federation on CIS Affairs, Eurasian Integration and Compatriots Relations, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly organized and held an online Round Table "The Century of Eurasia: a Conscious Partnership of Peoples".

The moderators were Ivan Belekov, Deputy of the State Duma of the Russian Federation, member of the Committee for the Commonwealth of Independent

States, Eurasian Integration and Compatriots Relations, and Svetlana Smirnova, First Deputy Secretary General – Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Chairman of the Council of the Assembly of Peoples of Russia, member of the Presidential Council for Interethnic Relations.

The purpose of the meeting is to update and prepare the International Altai Forum aimed at forming a conceptually new and promising civilizational and communicative channel of interaction within the Eurasian space. The Round Table was attended by cultural and public figures, historians, anthropologists, representatives of the educational community. 11 speakers made presentations on the issues of common historical and cultural ties of the Eurasian peoples, strengthening conscious cooperation in the interests of peace and development of peoples, the Altai experience of cross-border cooperation and the development of cross-border territories. The topics raised aroused the keen interest of the participants. There were made proposals to publish a collection of reports and continue the discussion.

April 22, online


September 4, Russia, Leningrad region

July 5, Russia, Voronezh

July 19, Russia, Bashkortostan, Ufa

VIII. PROJECTS IMPLEMENTATION

In its practical activities, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly widely supports international projects of various kinds.

February 14, Russia, Moscow

On February 14, the world celebrates International Book Giving Day, which brings together everyone who gives books and instills a love of reading. The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly is the initiator of the publication of books in the "Library of the Eurasian Peoples" series. Books are usually published in three languages - the original language, Russian and English. The series was opened by a collection of poems "Zamurzanye opanki", a poetic picture of the past and modern Serbian south.



The Assembly's library is replenished with new copies, and the Assembly is happy to give these books to its friends and partners. On the International Book Giving Day, Andrey Yavny, a member of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, a writer, researcher, and philosopher, gave his comments.

March 12, France, Paris

On the last day of the White Month (according to the Buryat tradition), the European Association of Buryat Culture GRALTAN and the ALTAN-ART Company in France held their first live broadcast dedicated to the White Month holiday - Sagaalgan as part of the International Festival "All the Colors of Eurasia".

This is a holiday of peace and kindness, reconciliation and friendship, honoring the elders. A symbol of the renewal of man and nature, openness of thoughts, hopes



and good expectations. The holiday is full of various mythological and ritual traditions. The live broadcast was also dedicated to a great cultural event that awaits the French public in November 2021: the Buryat song and dance theater "BAIKAL" is going to come to France with its new program.

April 25, Russia, Volokolamsk

On the day of the meeting of Soviet and American troops on the Elbe, the famous Russian composer and singer Oleg Popkov and the soloist of the Archipelago group Yulia Andreeva (AURA) for the first time publicly performed "THE PEACE SONG".

The song is addressed to all people as to the children of a single Mother Earth and presented by the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, an organization aimed to unite people, countries and peoples on the principles of love and respect for each other. Together with the leadership



of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Administration of the city of Volokolamsk, the performers took part in the flower-laying ceremony at the memorial of 28 Panfilovites and joined the "Garden of Peace" action.

June 1, Russia, online



On the International Children's Day, the results of the second stage of the International musical and humanitarian project "The Peace Song" were published. July 22, Russia, Ufa

November 1, Russia, Yekaterinburg, online



The IV International Eurasia Caricature Contest has started. It is aimed at developing good-neighbourly relations between the peoples of the Eurasian continent and the whole world. The theme of the contest is "Hello, neighbor!" The founders of the contest are Anatoly Pavlov, a member of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, chairman of the Sverdlovsk regional branch of the All-Russian Council of Local Self-Government, and the Yekaterinburg Museum of Caricature. November 8, Russia, Republic of Altai



At the end of the autumn expedition of the "Belt and Roads of Eurasia" project the interim results of the scientific research were summed up. The project leader is Doctor of Historical Sciences, Associate Professor of the University Center for Social Anthropology of the RSUH Maxim Mikhalev.

Since November 2020 he has been studying the role of ethnic factor in ensuring international security, in

preserving the traditional culture of the peoples and the natural treasures of Altai. The field material collected during the expedition in the Altai Territory and the Altai Republic is summarized, practical conclusions are drawn. They will be useful for intensifying mutually beneficial cooperation between peoples, which, in turn, will have a beneficial effect on the development of the economy and the growth of cross-border trade, as well as ensure mutual cultural enrichment of the peoples of the countries of Eurasia.

November 11-13, Turkey, Istanbul, online



On November 11, in Istanbul took place the opening of the V Eurasian Literary Festival of Festivals "LiFFt", supported by the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. After the symbolic transfer of the flag of the project from the representative of Azerbaijan to the winner of 2019, the Turkish poet Togrul Tanyol, the Chairman of the Literary Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Margarita Al opened the festival.

The participants were welcomed by: Svetlana Smirnova, First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly; Fernando Rendon, Alternative Nobel Prize winner and director of the Medellin Poetry Festival (Colombia); Anar Rzayev, chairman of the Writers' Union of Azerbaijan; Mehmet Nuri Parmaksiz, head of the Public Association of Owners of Scientific and Literary Works of Turkey (İLESAM); Olzhas Suleimenov, People's Writer of Kazakhstan; Konstantin Kedrov, poet (Russia). The festival was attended by 196 writers from 69 countries.

Ashraf Abul-Yazid, a poet from Egypt, writer and literary critic, founder of the Eurasian literary series "Silk Road", winner of the Manhae-Ashraf Dali World Prize, became the Gold Meda winners. The works of 90 writers and poets were included in the first volume of the literary publication "Living Anthology of Writers of the World". In addition, the anthology included 10 more authors, whose video works dialled most views on the YouTube channel of the festival. 36 participants of the festival were awarded Diplomas of Audience Attention. The works of all 196 participants will be published in a special issue of the LiFFt magazine. The award ceremony was watched by lovers of poetry and prose in 25 countries of Europe, 21 countries of Asia, 15 countries of North, Central and South America, 10 countries of Africa, New Zealand, as well as on the islands of Aruba, Barbados, Montserrat, Sao Tome and Principe.

November 24, Russia, Kazan, online

Deputy Head of the General Secretariat, Head of the "Theatrical Eurasia" project Elmira Shcherbakova took part in the international Symposium "Projects in Culture: Modern Models, Digital Technologies and Development Concepts" at the invitation of the Kazan State Institute of Culture. She made a report and presentation of the project "Theatrical Eurasia". The main goal of the project is to establish new public relations in the Eurasian space through the performances of the best theaters of the Eurasian countries in the live broadcast and in recording, to strengthen cultural and social ties between the peoples of the continent.

The project is especially in demand among young people, as it opens up new names and provides an opportunity for talented fashion designers to gain invaluable experience in international cultural partnership.

The winter expedition of the "Belt and Roads of Eurasia" project has come to an end. The project leader, a member of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Doctor of Historical Sciences, Associate Professor of the Educational and Scientific Center for Social Anthropology of the Russian State University for the Humanities, Maxim Mikhalev, together with colleagues - social anthropologists, as well as novice scientists - conducted research on living in settlements of small indigenous peoples of Russia and Australia. The reseach took place in settlements that had

previously been studied and visited by the project participants: several Evenki settlements of the Khabarovsk Territory, located in the Tugur-Chumikansky district, and several Australian aboriginal settlements on the Cape York Peninsula. During the expedition to Chumikan, it was found that the family albums, diaries and genealogies of modern residents: the descendants of the American Hutchinsons, Latvian Prussians, Yakuts Ivanovs, Russian Cossacks Khabarovs, Evenks Chepalovs or Koreans Pak depict the history of not only this small fishing village, but also the history of throughout Eurasia. Their descendants carefully preserve the memory of their ancestors, and it is these personal biographies of people from all over the world that became the basis for the conclusions that will make up a collective monograph devoted to research on the biographies of the inhabitants of the Far Eastern frontier.

December 7, Russia, Moscow

The press conference at the Plenipotentiary Representation of the Republic of Buryatia in Moscow was devoted to the creation of a computer game within the Call of the Ancestors project. The plot of the game recreates the legendary heroic epic of the Buryat people - "Geser". The ZovZemliCyber project, initiated by members of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly from St. Petersburg, plans to revive the epic heroes of antiquity



The project lasted from April to December 2021. More than 700 people took part in the project. 15 master



February 25, Russia, Moscow

It brought together participants from Russia, Latvia, Kazakhstan and Tajikistan - speakers from the Eurasian Peoples' Assemblyand experts from the RIA Novosti multimedia project "Nuremberg. The Beginning of the



World. The key theme of the discussion was the presentation of the international project of the Assembly - "Immortal Memory", which aims to identify and digitize the entire array of data from foreign archives, testifying of Nazi crimes against Soviet citizens. The project will also include materials made public at the conclusion of the Nuremberg Tribunal, which was the first in history to recognize aggression as the gravest criminal offense and to make public the Nazis' crimes against peace and humanity.

The project is aimed at social and creative development of children, expanding opportunities for their self-realization in the future, activation of public diplomacy based on the development of networking and personal contacts between children, approval of peace and mutual understanding as the main principles of communication.

Project tasks: to acquaint children with the life of their peers in different countries, to give children an opportunity to tell about their own vision of the world and their environment by publishing their stories, photo and video materials; to organize, support and develop information and cultural exchange in the online Internet and social media (the project has its own site) and offline on the sites of existing projects of the Eurasia nations Assembly. Every year, the project holds the "Sunflower" International Festival of Children's and Youth Media.

January, Russia, Udmurtia, Izhevsk



The next issue of the newspaper "School Monday" for blind children has been published. The first issue of 2021 is dedicated to the creation of the textbook "Journalism Lessons for the Blind" - a project implemented by the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" with the use of a grant from the President of the Russian Federation for social services, social

support and protection of citizens, provided by the Presidential Grants Fund.

"School Monday" is printed in Braille and has long been popular not only among children's readers, but also among adults. The editor of the newspaper is Anton Ponomarev, a boy with physical disabilities due to an eye disease.

The project "Teaching journalism to young people and children from 12 years of age with physical disabilities due to diseases of the eye and its adnexa "Journalism Lessons for the Blind" is a continuation of the joint activities of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Udmurt regional children's public organization "Zhuraveynik Social Production Center" in within the framework of the EURASIA KIDS project, launched in 2018.

Students from various universities came to practice in the EURASIA KIDSproject. Each of them came to the children with their own idea.

For the first time this day was held in 2006 at the initiative of the International Down Syndrome Association, and since 2012, as a global day of awareness, it has been officially celebrated by the United Nations. However, this does not prevent people with this syndrome from living a full life. They are very sincere in dealing with people; one

can and should take an example from them. "Sunny people" - that's what they are called, because people with Down syndrome charge everyone around with positive. "Sunny people" are very talented, versatile and inspiring.

Ebrima Mbenga, media mentor of the Children of Eurasia project, and his student Natasha Korobeynikova have been playing African drums together for a long time. This helps the "sunny girl" and brings joy to Ebrima.

April 2, 2021, online



On Children's Book Day. EURASIA KIDS organized a virtual meeting with the writer, who for many years gives joy to children with her work. Ksenia Dragunskaya knows firsthand how an ideal children's book should be. She has written 15 books for children, which received a warm response from readers. However, despite her success, Ksenia spoke sincerely and openly on a variety of topics.

April 30, 2021, online



On April 30, training seminars and a presentation of the project "Journalism training for young people and children from 12 years old with disabilities due to eye disease and its appendage "Journalism lessons for the blind," which was implemented with the help of a grant of the President of the Russian Federation for social services, social support and protection of citizens, provided by the Presidential Grants Foundation.

More than 1,000 copies of the textbook were given to young people with visual disabilities, as well as to workers of rehabilitation centers and libraries for use in their professional activities.

During the implementation of the project, there was made a survey, which made it possible to determine the level of social adaptation of children from 12 years old and young people of the target group to assess the interest among young people and children with visual impairments in the further development of their creative abilities. At the same time, a preliminary assessment of the satisfaction of the target groups with digital educational materials was carried out with the aim of further use in inclusive additional education. Also the level of awareness of children's parents with visual impairments about additional opportunities for planning a professional career was assessed.

May 9, 2021, online



"The hard happiness of the Great Victory". This is the name of the campaign launched on May 9 by the Department of Happiness and the EURASDIA KIDS project of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. Throughout the day, children told stories of people from different countries. Unique material collected by the children will help understand what feelings people had during the hard war time. These are not dry facts of statistics, these are living stories, which have the truth of wartime life, without falsehood and pathos.

May 21-22, 2021, Russia, Moscow

The EURASIA KIDS project "Tell me about your homeland. Eurasian School of Young Tourist Guide" was presented at the I International Forum "Culture. Tourism. Education. Synergy of Interactivity in Professional Space". The Forum was held on May 21-22, 2021, in Moscow in the cultural-entertaining complex "Kremlin in Izmailovo". The organizer of the project was Bogdan Zaitsev, a blind schoolboy from Udmurtia. Bogdan told about his experience in conducting nature tours in the museum space.



May 24, 2021, Russia, Moscow



A textbook on journalism for blind children was presented at the All-Russian Scientific and Practical Conference "The System of Comprehensive Rehabilitation of Students with Disabilities: the Experience of Interagency Cooperation". Project leader Olga Chirkova talked about the work on the textbook and the structure of the new audio edition for blind children. The project has three parts: theory, practice, and design.

May 26-27, online

The Department of Happiness and the project EURASIA KIDS took part in the first All-Russian Forum "Happy Cities". The organizer of the large-scale event, the Living Cities Community, has been researching the theme of Happiness in the life of cities and people in it for several years, discovering and testing new effective methods and approaches. The large-scale forum made it possible to exchange experience, to hear the opinions of the leading specialists of the country and the world and, most



importantly, to begin the implementation of the best solutions and practices in each city. The leading experts of Russia and of the world, the leaders of the city initiatives together with the participants created a set of recommendations which are applicable to any city and any conscious citizen.

June 1, online

The open lesson "Happy childhood of Eurasia" has become one of the main events of the International Children's Day. Its organizers - the Department of Happiness and EURASIA KIDS - invited professional journalists, teachers, directors, guides, media volunteers to cooperate. An open lesson is a story about the history of the holiday, about the problems that concern children and adults on the large Eurasian continent. June 3, Russia, Moscow

June 5, Russia, Udmurtia, Izhevsk




(ARS-PRESS), Alliance of Independent Regional Publishers, Children's Creative Union UNPRESS and League of Young Journalists.


December 8, online


February 15, Russia, Moscow

July 28, Russia, Kaluga region



The establishment of the Assembly proceeds from the realized need to strengthen the integration processes at the public level. Along with the expansion of mutually beneficial economic ties between states within the Eurasian partnership, it is important to simultaneously intensify the cultural and humanitarian cooperation of peoples, strengthen the interaction of non-governmental organizations, and create public structures aimed at the commonwealth.

It is on this affirming, basic principle of commonwealth that the further line of action of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly is proposed to build.
