



## Position about the International Inclusive Creative Festival "THE WORLD DRAWS HAPPINESS"

### 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. This Regulation defines the goals, objectives, organization and procedure of the International Inclusive Creative Festival "THE WORLD DRAWS HAPPINESS" (hereinafter - the "Festival").

1.2. The organizers of the Festival (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizers"):

International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Assembly of the Peoples of Eurasia";

Magazine "Aggregator of happiness"

Charity Foundation "The Good of Giving to the World",

Russian and International Makarenkov Association,

International Charity Foundation "Give Love to the World",

Support Center for creative initiatives "Zhuraveynik+",

Autonomous non-profit organization "Eurasian Center for the Support of the Institute of Family and Family Values"

1.3 The festival is held in online and offline format mainly on the territory of the countries of Eurasia.

1.4. This Regulation defines the procedure for organizing and holding the Festival, the stages of its program implementation and the determination of laureates.

### 2. GOALS AND SLOGANS OF THE FESTIVAL

2.1. The objectives of the Festival:

- to unite residents of different countries, representatives of different ethnic groups through the idea of a commonality of fundamental criteria for assessing personal happiness;

- acquaintance with the culture of the participants by means of art;

- development of interethnic empathy;

- cultivation of positive thinking ideas;

- development of creative initiative and aesthetic taste;

- support for joint creativity, including child-parent;

- strengthening good-neighborly relations through familiarization with spiritual and moral values, traditions and historical heritage of countries around the world.

2.2. Slogans of the Festival: happiness has no borders; happiness has no nationality; happiness has no age; happiness has no social status; happiness is in each of us.

### 3. РЕГЛАМЕНТ ФЕСТИВАЛЯ

3.1. The Festival is aimed at creating a creative collection of unique drawings, essays, creative works, as well as the formation of an international asset of the "Aggregator of Happiness".

3.2. The official page of the Festival is the portal "Aggregator of Happiness" <http://xn--80aaakal9dmekbhfl1e1d4b.xn--plai/> Media registration number: PI series No. FS77- 83874 dated 09/16/2022

3.3. Participation in the Festival is free of charge. Free of charge, the participant is given the

opportunity to take part in the International Festival, publish his work on the pages of the portal "Aggregator of Happiness".

3.4. Participation in the Festival can be individual (the Author's full name is indicated). Individuals aged 7 years and older can take part in the Festival.

3.5. Participation in the Festival can be collective (the name of the collective is indicated, the age category is chosen by the senior participant).

3.6. Children and youth, students and students of institutions of any type and type, their teachers, parents and all adults, as well as creative teams, regardless of age, are invited to take part in the Festival.

3.7. In order to implement the methodological and organizational support of the Festival at the international level, an Organizing Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Organizing Committee) is created, which is formed from representatives of the organizers, partners and experts of the Festival.

3.8. An Expert Jury (hereinafter referred to as the Jury) is created to examine the artistic materials received at the Festival and determine the winners of the Festival. Generalization and transfer of Jury materials is carried out by the Organizing Committee.

3.9. The Jury consists of experts on family values, cultural figures, public and state figures, media representatives. The competence of the Jury includes consideration of applications, approval of the list of laureates. The jury is headed by Nikas Safronov, People's Artist of the Russian Federation.

3.10. The Jury's decision is considered accepted if at least half of the Jury members present at the meeting voted for it. The decisions of the Jury are drawn up by a protocol, which is signed by the chairman of the Jury and his executive secretary.

3.11. Creative ideas on 7 (seven) topics are considered:

3.11.1. the emblem of happiness (DIY, drawing);

3.11.2. happiness when you are understood (DIY, drawing, essay);

3.11.3. happiness to love the Motherland (DIY, drawing, essay);

3.11.4. happiness attendants (drawing, essay);

3.11.5. happiness of the peoples of the world (DIY, drawing, essay);

3.11.6. happiness mail (DIY, drawing, essay);

3.11.7. the happiness of being a volunteer (DIY, drawing, essay);

3.12. Explanations of the nominations:

- Drawing - artwork made in any technique of execution, the drawing must be made on a sheet of A4 or A3 format.

- Handicraft - all kinds of decorative and applied art (applique, embroidery, burning, wood carving, painting on various materials, wood products, clay, etc.);

- Essay - a story of his own composition, the maximum number of characters (with spaces!) it should be 3500.

3.13. In each of the 7 (seven) topics, the laureates and in each nomination, the results are summed up by age groups:

from 7 to 9 years old;

from 10 to 14 years old;

from 16 years and older.

3.14. Each work is sent by a separate application. Applications for participation in the Festival, after summing up, are not subject to correction and deletion. Works submitted to the Festival are not reviewed and are not returned.

3.15. The participant of the Festival is the author of a creative work. The person who sent the work to the Festival is responsible for authorship and copyright compliance in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation.

3.16. The working languages of the Festival are Russian and English.

3.17. Information about the Festival is posted on the information resources of the organizers and partners of the Festival, in the media.

3.18. This Provision has the force of a Contract (Public Offer). When submitting an application for the Festival, the terms of the Contract are considered agreed, and the Contract is concluded.

#### 4.DATES, STAGES AND RESULTS OF THE FESTIVAL

- 4.1. Events within the stages of the Festival are held from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023. The rules of the Festival program are approved by the decision of the Organizing Committee.
- 4.2. The reception of creative works takes place in 4 stages with summing up for each.
- 4.3. Dates of the Festival stages  
 Stage I "Acceptance of works for the Festival":  
 from January 1 to March 15,  
 from April 1 to June 15,  
 from July 1 to September 15,  
 from October 1 to December 1.  
 Stage II "Summing up the results of the Festival": April 1, July 1, October 1, December 5.  
 Stage III "Final": from December 5 to December 30, 2023 summing up the results of the annual Festival in the Video Conference format.
- 4.4. The results of the Festival are posted on the portal "Aggregator of happiness" <http://xn--80aaakal9dmekbhfle1d4b.xn--p1ai/>.
- 4.5. In each nomination, 3 laureates are determined in accordance with the approved age categories. Additionally, a special nomination "Star of social networks" is being established. The winners are determined from the participants of the 3rd stage of the Festival ("Final") in accordance with the approved age categories by open voting on the Organizers' social networks.
- 4.6. The examination and evaluation of Festival works is carried out by the Festival Jury. The works are evaluated by the Jury according to the following criteria:
  - 4.6.1. the level of artistic skill of the work performed (technique);
  - 4.6.2. composite solution;
  - 4.6.3. artistic taste, originality of the author's manner;
  - 4.6.4. the color scheme of the work, expressiveness, the overall impression of the work;
  - 4.6.5. the culture of the design of the work, the conformity of the work with the theme of the Festival, the present Position and the age of the participant.
- 4.7. The winners' works are entitled to:
  - 4.7.1. to participate in international exhibitions in the territory of the Eurasian countries;
  - 4.7.2. become an illustration of postcards #letters of happiness;
  - 4.7.3. to be published in the First anti-stress media with positive content, the Happiness Aggregator Magazine.
- 4.8. According to the results of the Festival, the laureates in each nomination are awarded with Diplomas of various degrees by the decision of the jury. Other participants, as well as teachers, managers and institutions, associations are awarded Certificates of the Festival participant with words of gratitude.

#### 5. REQUIREMENTS FOR FESTIVAL MATERIALS

- 5.1. The Festival accepts applications according to the following algorithm::
  - 5.1.1. Publish on the personal page of any social network information that the author of the work is taking part in the Festival and photos of the work using hashtags #МирРисуетСчастье#TheWorldPaintsHappiness #АгрегаторСчастья and indicating the information link to the account of the magazine "Aggregator of happiness" - <https://vk.com/agregatorschastyia>

- 5.1.3. Send to [skazka@give-world.com](mailto:skazka@give-world.com), specifying the full name of the author and the name of the Festival work, a scan or photo of a drawing / photo of a creative work / essay in Word format.
- 5.1.4. Send the originals of creative works by postal service or courier delivery to the address: 4A Uspensky Lane, Moscow, Russian Federation, addressed to Marina Leonidovna Volkova, Chairman of the organizing committee.
- 5.2. The application provides for the participation of one work in one nomination.
- 5.3. The author has the right to fill out no more than three applications for participation in three different nominations, while one creative work / drawing / essay cannot be submitted in several nominations.
- 5.4. The works submitted to the Festival must be accompanied by the following information:
- 5.4.1. name of the Festival, theme/nomination,
- 5.4.2. author's title of the work,
- 5.4.3. Full name and date of birth of the participant,
- 5.4.4. locality, city, country of residence of the participant,
- 5.4.5. Full name of the mentor / supervisor / curator of the participant and his position (if any) the name of the educational organization with a brief indication of the organizational and legal form (GO, MKOU, MBOU, MAOU, etc.)
- 5.4.6. in the group work, the name of the creative group is indicated (the names of the authors can be indicated in the note),
- 5.4.7. in the note you can specify any additional data, explanations.
- 5.5. Admission to participate in the Festival is carried out in case of compliance with the requirements for the works and other requirements established by this Regulation, including confirmation that the participant is the rightful owner of the work submitted to the Festival. Materials that do not meet the specified requirements cannot participate in the Festival.
- 5.6. By filling out the questionnaire of the Festival participant, the participant confirms that he is familiar with these Regulations, including the requirements for Festival materials.
- 5.7. The Participant of the Festival gives full and irrevocable consent to the use by the Organizers of the work sent to participate in the Festival in all ways, indicating the name of the author without additional conditions and payments of royalties or other deductions.
- 5.8. The works of the participants can be published on the pages of the accounts of the organizers and partners of the Festival in social networks with the indication of the author's full name and the declared nomination. The works corresponding to this Regulation are published on the Portal "Aggregator of Happiness" within 7 days. After publication, the works are available for viewing in the menu Works /Gallery of creative works.
- 5.9. By entering personal data into the registration form of the Festival Participant (including data of minors), the Participant fully and unconditionally accepts the terms of the Agreement on the processing of personal data.

## 6. FINANCING OF THE FESTIVAL

- 6.1 Payment of expenses related to the preparation and holding of events within the framework of the Festival program is carried out at the expense of its Organizers and partners.
- 6.2. The prize fund is financed from the own funds of the Organizers and partners of the Festival.
- 6.3. Payment of expenses related to the delivery of festival works to the address specified in clause 5.1.4 of this Regulation is carried out from the participant's own funds.
