

REGULATIONS

on the Contest of Research Works “Great Victory of 1945 - Pride of Descendants”

General Provisions

1.1. This Regulation regulates the conduct of the Research Contest “Great Victory of 1945 - Pride of Descendants” (the "Contest"), devoted to 75-th anniversary of Victory in the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945, as part of the project “Crimean School of the Eurasian Union” through a Grant of the President of the Russian Federation on development of civil society provided by the presidential grants.

1.2. The organizer and performer of the Contest events is the Sevastopol Regional branch of the All – Russian Public Organization the “Assembly of the peoples of Russia” (hereinafter - the Organizer).

1.4. The organization and conduct of the Contest is based on the principles of accessibility, free personal development and freedom of creative expression of participants.

1.5. The Contest is declared open from the moment of sending this Regulation to educational institutions, its publishing on the Internet on the official website of the Assembly of peoples of Russia, official pages in social networks.

1.6. Information about the Contest is published on the official website of the Organizer (<http://evrazschoolsevastopol.ru/>) and in the media.

Contest Goals and Objectives

2.1. Goals:

- Education of the young generation in the spirit of patriotism, citizenship and respect for the exploits of veterans of the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945, the development and formation of historical consciousness of the individual, interest in the events of the past.

- Supporting young people in conducting historical research.

2.2. Tasks:

- Increasing the level of interest of children and youth to the events of the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945, to the history of their Native land;
- Assistance to the younger generation in understanding the significance of the victory in the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945, in the history of our state and the impact it had on world history.

Contest period

The competition is held from June 15 to August 1, 2020.

Contest Stages

- First stage: from 15 June to 27 July 2020 - sending this Regulation to educational institutions of the city of Sevastopol, participants work, acceptance of participants' applications and contest works by the Organizer. July 27, 2020 is the last day of works' acceptance.
- Second stage: July 28 - July 31, 2020 - meeting of the Jury, determining the winners of the Contest, publishing the names of the winners on the website and in official networks.
- Third stage: August 1 - announcement of the winners
- The fourth stage: awarding the winners with diplomas and Souvenirs; presentation of the winners at the cultural and educational conference "Heritage of the Great Victory - Pride of Descendants". The conference will be held in Sevastopol. Along with face-to-face participation, remote participation is also possible. Information about the date of the conference will be posted on the Organizer's website.

Research Papers Requirements, Evaluation Criteria

The Contest involves research works in one of the following themes:

- Essence of the Feat of the Fatherland Defenders in 1941-1945 and the Meaning of the Great Victory in 1945;
- Role of the Soviet Union in the Second World War of 1939-1945, in the Victory over Fascism;
- Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945 in the History of my Family;
- History of the Native Land during the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945;
- Humanity at War, Love for the Motherland and Comrades, Friendship, Heroism in Literary Works about the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945;

- Excursion to the Monuments of the Native Land Dedicated to the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945;
- Participation of Search Organizations in the Study of the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945;
- Works of Culture (literature, fine art, theater, cinema) Created in the USSR during the Great Patriotic war of 1941-1945: the Ideas and Meaning embedded by the authors.

Contest entries can be submitted in paper format or in video format (with or without editing images; in the second case - with the demonstration of paper copies or original photos in front of the camera). The same research can be presented in both paper and video formats, but in this case the content must be the same.

Each participant can submit several research papers.

Each entry must be accompanied by a request for participation in the Contest (standard form, see Annex 1); the consent of the legal representatives of the participant who have not attained 14 years, on a possible location of the video on the official website of the Organizer; a possible publication of text research in electronic and printed versions of the media; to use study materials to prepare internal Organizer's reports (a sample consent, see Appendix 2).

Competitive works are evaluated comprehensively according to the following criteria:

- disclosure of one of the topics in the competitive research (see paragraph 4.2);
- presence of formulated goals and objectives of the research;
- availability at the end of the study of a list of articles and books that were used in the research (examples of articles and books for the list, see Appendix 3);
- availability at the beginning of the research text (in writing or in a video presentation) of a review of the scientific articles or books that have been read (if this is supposed to be the subject of the research);
- presence of references to articles and books from which this or that information mentioned in the article was taken. (for writing links, see Annex 4);
- having your own thoughts;
- availability of images (including photos) in the study;

- availability of annotations (captions) to images;
- appeal to the images (commenting them out) in the text of the study;
- availability of conclusions in the study.

Contest Jury

The Contest Jury is formed by the Organizer from among the staff of the Assembly of peoples of Russia, the teaching staff of universities.

The Jury consists of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and members of the jury.

The personal composition of the Jury is determined no later than 5 days before the deadline for accepting entries.

A meeting of the Jury is considered competent if at least 2/3 of its members take part in it.

The Secretary of the Jury provides organizational and technical preparation of the Jury session.

Procedure for the Contest Works Consideration

- Consideration of the submitted works is held at the Jury session within four days after the completion of the works acceptance.
- At the meeting, the Secretary announces the number of received works in each subject group.
- The submitted works are submitted for discussion by the Jury members.
- Based on the results of the discussion, the Jury selects the best works in each thematic group.
- The winner of the Contest in each thematic group is determined by a simple majority of votes from the number of Jury members present by open voting. In case of equality of votes, the vote of the Chairman of the Jury is decisive.
- The results of the Contest are drawn up in a Protocol signed by the Chairman and Secretary of the Jury.

Contest Awards

7.1. The winners are awarded Diplomas and Souvenirs.

7.2. In each thematic group (see clause 4.2), the Organizer has determined three prizes (1, 2, 3).

7.3. Certificates are awarded to teachers who have prepared prize-winners in each thematic group.

7.4. The Research of the Contest winners is published on the official website of the Organizer and on its official pages in social networks.

7.5. The winners of the Contest are invited to speak at the cultural and educational conference “Heritage of the Great Victory - Pride of Descendants”, which will be held in Sevastopol. Along with face-to-face participation, remote participation is also possible.

7.6. All participants of the Contest are provided with a Certificate confirming their participation.

The Regulation on the Contest with apps
